Shelter



Providing welcoming, safe accommodations, IPH operates five emergency shelters throughout Albany, Fulton, and Montgomery Counties for neighbors experiencing homelessness. Our shelters minimize barriers that often prevent people from accessing services, while offering around-the-clock compassionate support.



HEALTHY & NUTRITIOUS MEALS

Feed people in need. The hearty, homecooked dinner guests receive at IPH might be the only meal they eat on any given day.

Access to personal care items, such as shampoo, deodorant, and lotion, helps improve guests' confidence and self-worth.

Community



At our daytime drop-in center, Community Connections, guests can access meals, a clothing pantry, laundry, mailboxes, lockers, showers, and individualized, person-centered case management. Our Albany Ambassadors Employment Program allows unhoused neighbors to earn an income and build a reputable work history through our partnership with the City Mission of Schenectady and local theatres.



BUS TOKEN

Cover the cost of transportation so that an unhoused neighbor can access vital services at Community Connections, the only drop-in center in the Albany area.

Covering the cost of new identification creates a path to stability and financial security for people who otherwise couldn't set up a bank account, apply for housing, or seek employment.

Children in IPH housing receive support accessing education and the tools they need to learn and grow, including backpacks, pencils and notebooks.

Reduce barriers to shelter. Our staff meet unhoused neighbors where they're at through community outreach. Often this is how guests first learn about IPH programs.




